2025 ELECTIVE CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Ages/grades are based on the current 2024-2025 school year

1. ARCHERY (All ages)

In addition to shooting at targets, campers will have a blast learning the art of basic archery skills and techniques, and of course, safety precautions. (In the event of inclement weather, campers will be inside learning various outdoor skills.)

2. ART (All ages)

Our art teachers are planning fun projects where campers will have the opportunity to create multi-dimensional artwork using different mediums, including drawing, painting and crafting.

3. BEAUTY PARLOR (1st - 6th grade)

Led by a local beautician, campers will learn and practice the basics of braiding, make up, and nail care. Each camper will receive a bag of supplies.

4. CHESS (K - 6th grade)

The chess team will teach all levels of chess players. When registering, share the child's level of experience (beginner, intermediate, advanced).

5. DANCE - Line Dancing (3rd-6th)

Step, slide, and stomp -- this energetic class is about learning to line dance. No boots or experience needed.

6. DANCE & MOVEMENT (PreK & K)

Younger campers will have fun dancing and moving to music in this high energy class!

7. GAMES (All ages)

Would your child rather be active outside? Our games team will keep everyone having fun with age-appropriate games that will be enjoyed by all!

8. KNITTING (5th & 6th grade)

Campers will learn how to knit, how to cast on and off, and basic knitting terminology. For beginners; no experience needed. For those who know how to knit, campers will learn new types of stitches. When registering, share the child's level of experience (beginner, intermediate, advanced).

9. LEATHER WORKING (2nd - 6th grade)

Campers will have fun working on various leather projects using punching, stamping, and lacing techniques. Projects vary from year to year.

10. MACRAME (5th & 6th grade)

Boys and girls will enjoy tying a bookshelf to hang their books. Macrame involves lots of knots and fun with rope. (Picture of project to the right)

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11. MUSIC (PreK)

Our youngest campers will enjoy some fun with music, including singing, movement, and musical activities.

12. SENSORY (All ages)

Does your child love to play with slime, oobleck, and water beads? Sensory play improves memory, brain development, and motor skills but your campers will find it just plain fun!

13. TEXTILE ARTS (All ages - projects listed by age)

Fun with sewing machines and hand stitching.
